The Construction Oversight and Value Engineering Committee (COVE) monthly meeting convened on Thursday June 25, 2015 at 8:06 a.m., at Facilities Services, 6501 Magic Way, Bldg. 200, Orlando, Florida 32809.

COVE Members in Attendance: Ksenia Merck, James Knapp, Douglas Kelly, Fred MacDonald, Mario Cuello and Stuart Kramer.

OCPS Staff in Attendance: Dr. Barbara Jenkins, Faz Ali, Regina Frazier-Thomas, Jeff Hart, John Morris, Roberto Pacheco, Mike Winter, Laura Kelly, Toni Greene, Tom Moore, Basem Ghneim and Arman Pourmirza (as scribe).

Call to Order

A quorum was established and Chairman Ksenia Merck called the meeting to order at 8:06 a.m.

Approval of Minutes

Mario Cuello asked that construction technology be added to the meeting schedule as a component of the update on digital technology. Chair Merck also added a Lessons Learned in September, which would include an orientation update, and an annual sales tax update.

The minutes from May 21, 2015 were presented and approved unanimously by the Committee.

Discussion Items

Community Communication was added to the Agenda for discussion.

Mr. Morris discussed how Lauren Roth will be contacting media outlets and communities to establish lines of communication. He also mentioned the importance of community meetings for each school projects in design and construction. He further added that for the upcoming year, starting in August 2015 to June 2016, OCPS will host up to or possibly more than 90 community meetings. Positive changes are also being made to the OCPS Facilities website to ensure that accurate information is presented and shared with the public. The website updates will help inform the public on the progress of the school projects. Mr. Morris also addressed the effort to update the content of the website more frequently.



Dr. Jenkins addressed the duty of the COVE in relation to the media and communicating with the public by stating that COVE has a supporting role of oversight to OCPS and as such they envision COVE as an independent and advisory committee and not one with responsibilities that require consistently addressing media issues. It was stated that all community communications and media affairs to COVE should be addressed to the Committee Chair.

The Committee Chair requested to keep the Community Communication item on the agenda for all COVE meetings.

Dr. Jenkins welcomed a proactive approach to Community Communication and Media Relations and welcomed Lauren Roth, the newly hired OCPS Facilities Communication Sr. Manager, to OCPS.

Mr. Morris also noted that the Real Estate department is reviewing the option of land banking and currently reviewing soliciting the services of a private sector real estate agent/broker to represent the District.

The importance of the correct news story making it to the media, as far as land purchases and site related project matters, was reiterated by Dr. Jenkins and Mr. Morris. Mr. Morris noted that community meetings will be scheduled prior to land acquisitions.

Project Status

Jeff Hart provided a monthly status update for new/replacement and comprehensive projects as well as projects in close-out. He informed the Committee that all eleven projects under construction are tracking on schedule and that the value of these projects is \$273M.

Avalon Area MS (site 21-M-E-2) - New relief MS project originally slated for a construction NTP for this summer has been postponed pending OCPS acquiring additional property.

Action Item

Pat Knipe requested an update on the "List of 136" school projects. The update will be made available at the next COVE meeting.

Change Order Report

Roberto Pacheco reported that during the month of May 2015 there was one significant Change Order that exceeded \$200,000. OCPS Board has reviewed and approved the Change Order.

Follow up Item



Furthermore, Roberto Pacheco outlined a list of RFQ's currently soliciting different services. He also presented the list of LDB and M/WBE firms and all the sub-consultants that have provided Program Management services to OCPS.

Capital Renewal Update

Mike Winter provided an update on the Capital Renewal Program/Project Summary for fiscal year 2014-2016. The report indicated the budget and schedule for each project under planning, design, and construction.

Pat Knipe inquired if we are tracking total dollars on the Capital expenditures. It was acknowledged that this is an accumulation. Judith Padres will produce a summary report to support that data.

Demographics, land Maps and CIP Presentation

Faz Ali and Tom Moore provided an update on Demographics and CIP Projections. The presentation included details on the methodology to project student numbers and how birth rate studies impact the estimation of student counts in various neighborhoods. The birthrates, family demographics and enrollment counts for the entire District were graphically shown. Tom Moore concluded that the data is collected year around and that adjustments are made annually to correct any anomalies effecting enrollment and budget planning projections. Dr. Jenkins highlighted the importance of this scientific methodology and the approach OCPS takes in our planning process and budget projections.

Dr. Jenkins discussed the impact of charter schools on enrollment statistics. Also, she emphasized the notion of updating the 10 year CIP on yearly basis and the importance of that action.

The OCPS magnet programs were discussed and their effects on enrollment was questioned. Enrollment statistics and information for the OCPS magnet programs will be provided.

Pat Knipe asked about the yearly under/over projections of this methodology. Tom Moore will prepare a chart depicting actuals vs. projected for the past few years.

Laura Kelly addressed a question about land banking and if OCPS has any time restrictions on purchasing land and when the actual project is planned for that land. Dr.



Jenkins added that as a public entity our land purchasing policies are need based and not profit driven.

Vote:

Two Items were voted on:

- 1. Cancelling the July COVE meeting.
- 2. Conducting a tour of the two newly constructed schools for the August COVE meeting which was changed to August 13, 2015.

Both Items Passed.

Chair and Pat Knipe discussed moving sales tax update to the quarterly vs. annual presentations and clarified that in order to properly orient new members of COVE, the timing is best set for September of each year.

Also, Pat Knipe questioned and requested a report on Facility Insurance and Asset Protection which would be provided through the Risk Management Department.

Adjournment

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 10:00 a.m.

The next meeting will be Thursday, August 13, 2015, at 8 a.m., at Facilities Services, 6501 Magic Way, Bldg. 200, at which time a school bus will be available to provide travel for the tour of two newly constructed schools.

Construction Update as of July 30, 2015

We now have **10 projects under construction** amounting to approx. **\$257M.**

5 – Comprehensive = \$154,241,000

- **Dr. Phillips HS** (Comprehensive Renovation) NTP issued on Sept. 2012, (30 month schedule), contracted SC March 16, 2015.
 - The project accounted for a new classroom building, new building expansion for the Visual and Performing Arts, renovations of the Auditorium/Band/Art, Administration, Gymnasium, Cafeteria/Kitchen, Media Center and Classroom buildings, which have all been substantially completed.
 - The final phase of the project related to site work has been completed; however, final substantial completion of this final phase of work remains pending until the CM can clear up all inspection issues with BCCO within the myGov permitting system.
- Cypress Creek HS (Comprehensive Renovation) NTP issued on November 19, 2013, SC expected Feb 2016.
 - Phases 1 & 2 involving a new classroom building and Central Energy Plant, renovation of the Gymnasium, renovation of Building 800 – Art and ROTC classrooms, and the construction of a new softball field concession building have been completed.
 - In addition, phase 3, which accounts for the renovation of Classroom building 700 (Science) and the Media Center building where substantially completed on July 17, 2015.
 - Phase 4A renovation of Building 200 Auditorium commenced over Spring Break, and is scheduled to be substantially complete by Oct. 6th, 2015.
 - Phase 4B renovation of the Cafeteria/Kitchen commenced on June 5th and is being accelerated over the summer months to be completed by August 17th.
 - Phase 4C renovations of classroom Building 600 and Administration Building 100 commenced on June 15th and is scheduled to be substantially complete by Dec. 15, 2015.
- Apopka ES (Comprehensive Renovation) NTP issued August 8th, and its initial phase involving the replacement of the core facilities and classrooms was substantially completed on June 30th, 2015, with the renovation of an existing classroom building and associated site amenities scheduled to be substantially completed by August 10th, and final phase SC expected Nov. 2nd, 2015.



- Lake Whitney ES (Comprehensive Renovation) NTP issued Sept. 19, 2014.
 - Phases 1 thru 3 involving the renovation of classroom building 3 and a new CEP, renovation of classroom building 5, and renovation of classroom building 2 have been completed.
 - Building 6 previously scheduled to be completed by September 4th, was substantially completed on July 26th, while the balance of the work involving the renovation of the core areas are tracking completion for early August.
- Westridge MS (Phase 2) NTP was issued on March 6th for the final phase which accounts for the demolition of the original Shingle Creek ES building and for the provision of new athletic and site related amenities for the new MS. This final phase is scheduled to be substantially complete by August 7th, 2015.

Note: Budget value for Westridge MS Phase 2 scope of work amounts to \$1,500,000. This amount has been calculated into the above overall cost of the Comprehensive projects amounting to \$154,241,000 vs. carrying the total Board adopted budget value for the Westridge MS project of \$32,092,000. In addition, since additional sitework is being performed at Lake Silver ES, post substantial completion of the primary project, the project is still being listed under the construction section; however, the total project budget for same is not accounted for within the comprehensive projects value listed above. Thus the difference between the total Board adopted Budget value for Comprehensive projects of \$200,193,000 listed on the Project Status Summary Report spreadsheet.

And,

5 - New/Replacements = \$102,813,952

- Eagle Creek ES (New) NTP was issued on August 8th, and the contractual substantial completion was scheduled for June 23, 2015. The Hard Bid General Contractor is delinquent and is currently expected to be substantially complete late July/Early August.
- Clay Springs ES (Replacement) NTP was issued on August 21st, and the initial substantial completion providing a new replacement facility was accomplished on July 8th. The balance of the project accounts for the demo of the existing facility and for the provision of the playfields and is scheduled to be substantially completed by November 11, 2015.
- Wedgefield Area K-8 (Site 2-K8-E-1) NTP was issued on May 5th, and the SC is scheduled for June 30th, 2016.
- Tangelo Park ES (Replacement) NTP was issued on July 1st, and the SC is scheduled for May 13, 2016.
- Site 81-E-SW-5 (Millenia Area Relief) NTP was issued on July 9th, and the SC is scheduled for May 31, 2016.



Since our meeting in June:

- Substantial completions to report:
 - Lovell ES (Replacement) substantial completion was achieved on June 29, 2015, and the swing back from Apopka 9th grade has occurred.
 - **Apopka ES** its initial phase involving the replacement of the core facilities and a portion of the classrooms was substantially completed on June 30, 2015.
 - **Clay Springs ES** (Replacement) the initial substantial completion providing a new replacement facility was accomplished on July 8, 2015.
 - Lake Weston ES (Replacement) substantial completion was achieved on July 8, 2015, and the swing back from Clarcona ES has occurred.
 - **Cypress Creek HS** phase 3, the renovation of Classroom building 700 (Science) and the Media Center where substantially completed on July 17, 2015.
 - Lake Whitney ES Building 6 classrooms which were previously scheduled to be completed by September 4th, was substantially completed early on July 26, 2015.
 - Independence ES (New) substantial completion was achieved on July 27, 2015.

Anticipated future milestones:

- **Eagle Creek ES** (New) substantial completion is currently expected to be substantially complete by the end of July/early August.
- Lake Whitney ES balance of the work involving the renovation of Building 100 and 400 core areas, are tracking completion for early August.
- Westridge MS (Phase 2) Final phase which accounts for the demolition of the original Shingle Creek ES building and for the provision of new athletic and site related amenities for the new MS is scheduled to be substantially complete by August 7th, 2015.
- **Clay Springs ES** intermediate phase accounting for the demolition of the existing facility and the replacement of the parent drop off/pickup drive and parking is scheduled to be completed by August 7, 2015.
- **Apopka ES** intermediate phase accounting for the renovation of an existing classroom building and associated site work are scheduled to be substantially completed by August 10, 2015.
- **Cypress Creek HS** Phase 4B renovation of the Cafeteria/Kitchen is scheduled to be completed by August 17, 2015.

- We currently have 8 projects in close-out;
 - Waterford ES (Comprehensive) Substantial Completion was achieved on July 29th, 2014.
 - Shingle Creek ES (Replacement) Substantial Completion was achieved on August 8th, 2014.
 - **Ocoee ES** (Replacement) achieved its 2nd phase and a final substantial completion on Nov. 7, 2014.
 - **Pineloch ES** (Replacement) achieved its 2nd phase and a final substantial completion on Nov. 7, 2014.
 - John Young ES (Replacement) achieved its 2nd phase and a final substantial completion on Nov. 18, 2014.
 - Lovell ES (Replacement) substantial completion was achieved on June 29, 2015.
 - Independence ES (New) substantial completion was achieved on July 27, 2015.
 - Lake Weston ES (Replacement) substantial completion was achieved on July 8, 2015.

New projects currently bidding - The following projects are scheduled to commence with construction later this summer and are currently in the bidding/GMP negotiation phase. The projects are: Riverside ES, Dream Lake ES and Lockhart ES, all of which are comprehensive renovation projects. To take advantage of the summer break, early demo packages have been awarded and have commenced for Dream Lake ES and Lockhart ES.

In addition, Site 117-E-SW-4 (Summerlake Area Relief) and Ventura ES Replacement projects are in the final phase of design and are scheduled to commence this September with summer of 2016 completions.

Avalon Area MS (Site 21-M-E-2) – site redesign modifications are taking place and being resubmitted to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) for review and approval. Target date for BCC approval is Nov 2015, with a target construction NTP of January 2016. School occupancy is now slated for summer 2016.

OCPS FACILITIES & CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTING RFQs in Progress: July 2015
