The Construction Oversight and Value Engineering Committee (COVE) monthly meeting convened on Thursday, May 17, 2018 at 8:00 a.m., at Facilities Services, 6501 Magic Way, Bldg. 200, Orlando, Florida 32809.

COVE Members in Attendance: Chairman Ksenia Merck, Vice-Chairman Pat Knipe, James Knapp, and Mario Cuello.

Call to Order:

A quorum was established and Chairman Ksenia Merck called the meeting to order at 8:08 a.m.

I. Approval of Minutes

The minutes from April 19, 2018 were presented and unanimously approved by the Committee.

Action Item

Chairman Merck requested an update on Capital Renewal Program at June's Meeting.

II. Departmental Reports

> **Project Status** – Mari Espinal/Jeff Hart

- <u>Mari Espinal</u>
 - There is one significant change to report this month; the estimated cost of completion for Magnolia School and Behavior Center has increased approximately \$8.3 million.
- Jeff Hart
 - Currently there are 15 projects under construction amounting to approximately \$403 million.
 - Since our last meeting three (3) projects have received CFI's (Dr. Phillips HS, Mollie Ray ES, and Ivey Lane ES).
- <u>Comments/Questions</u>
 - COVE Members questioned the increase for Magnolia School and Behavior Center. Jeff reported the increase combines the funding from Gateway and Cherokee with Magnolia. He also noted that



based on the scope of work involved with combining the schools onto one campus, it is anticipated that the budget will increase to approximately \$45 million.

- Pat Knipe asked for an explanation of the "Variance" column on the Project Status Report and why it was usually positive. Jeff Hart explained that OCPS carried a 2% reserve with the GMP.
- Mario Cuello asked about the 60-90 days delay for Pine Hills Transportation Compound. Jeff explained that it is due to unsuitable soils that was discovered on site. He also mentioned that there is approximately \$2 million in claims associated with the recently discovered unsuitable soils.
- Action Item
 - Chairman Merck requested a footnote be added to the report for Magnolia outlining the special circumstances affecting the increase in the budget.

> Change Order Report – Ed Ames

- <u>Discussion</u>
 - There are no significant change orders or amendments to report for the month of February.
 - Currently, there are four (4) RFQ's out for bid.

> Capital Renewal Update – Jeff Hart

- <u>Discussion</u>
 - Update on the capital renewal projects, highlighting each project in either planning, design, construction, close-out or completed.
- <u>Comments/Questions</u>



- Mario Cuello asked about the cost associated with Digital Curriculum. Mike Winter said the cost per classroom varies between seven to ten thousand dollars, excluding student devices.
- Pat Knipe asked about the Capital Renewal Fund balance. Judith Padres said it is \$660 million and \$287 million has been spent.
- Pat Knipe asked about the ODP program. Jeff Hart said that it is for purchase of materials using the sales tax exemption. He also mentioned that since 2007 the District has saved approximately \$18.7 million with the ODP program.
- <u>Action Item</u>
 - Chairman Merck asked to have a bar chart showing dollars and areas of commitment per phase of capital renewal.

Construction Update as of June 12, 2018

We now have 18 projects under construction amounting to approx. \$469M.

5 – Comprehensive = \$106,204,000

- Sally Ride ES (Replacement/Renovation) Combination of Cypress Park ES and Durrance ES into one new school on the Cypress Park ES site. Construction NTP was issued July 17, 2017, and involves a complete replacement of the core facilities and a portion of the classrooms, along with the renovation of two existing single story classroom buildings. Initial substantial completion was scheduled for May 24, 2018, and is now expected within the next week. Final overall substantial completion is scheduled for October 15, 2018.
- Dover Shores ES (Replacement/Renovation) NTP was issued July 18, 2017, and involves a complete replacement of the core facilities and a portion of the classrooms, along with the renovation of one existing single story classroom building. In addition, due to the required scope of work and site limitations, school functions have been temporarily relocated to the Old Engelwood ES campus; therefore, this project will also account for the demo of the existing Old Engelwood ES campus and the redevelopment of the Jackson MS athletic fields, for which new Engelwood ES now sits upon. The overall substantial completion of the Dover Shores ES site is scheduled for June 14, 2018, and the overall substantial completion of the Jackson MS athletic amenities is scheduled for November 2018.
- Hillcrest ES (Replacement/Renovation) NTP was issued July 27, 2017, and involves a complete replacement of the core facilities and a portion of the classrooms, along with the renovation and repurposing of an existing two story building. The overall substantial completion is scheduled for June 21, 2018. In addition, due to the required scope of work and site limitations, school functions have been temporarily relocated to the old Fern Creek ES campus.
- Union Park ES (Replacement/Renovation) NTP was issued July 27, 2017, and involves a complete replacement of the core facilities and a portion of the classrooms, along with the renovation of two existing single story classroom buildings. The initial substantial completion of the new building was scheduled for May 23, 2018, and is now expected within the next week. The overall substantial completion is scheduled for October 26, 2018.
- **Corner Lake MS (**Comprehensive/Renovation) NTP was issued on March 9, 2018, and involves four separate phases with an overall substantial completion scheduled for July 26, 2019.



And,

13 - New/Replacements = \$362,303,000

- Lake Como School Site 205-K8-SW-6 (Replacement) Construction NTP was issued on February 7, 2017 and achieved a substantial completion on May 11th, a few days ahead of the scheduled May 14, 2018 date. A subsequent site phase substantial completion of June 19, 2018 was agreed upon to account for the additional time associated with the arsenic abatement within the track and field areas. School functions have been temporarily relocated (swung) to Kaley ES for the 2016-2018 school years.
- Audubon Park School Site 133-K8-N-6 (Replacement) Construction NTP was issued on March 17, 2017 with a substantial completion scheduled for June 15, 2018. Currently, this project is running approximately 4 weeks behind schedule.
- Frangus ES (Replacement) construction NTP was issued on July 25, 2017, with a main building substantial completion scheduled for May 31, 2018. Subsequent existing building demo and related site work is scheduled to be completed by October 30, 2018. Due to a recent approval through the County for an offsite water main point of connection, the initial building phase substantial completion is now anticipated mid-July 2018.
- Pine Hills ES (Replacement) construction NTP was issued on July 20, 2017, with an overall project substantial completion scheduled for June 29, 2018. Due to the required scope of work and site limitations, school functions have been temporarily relocated to the old Clarcona ES campus.
- **Hidden Oaks ES** (Replacement) construction NTP was issued on July 24, 2017, and achieved a main building substantial completion, as scheduled, on June 8, 2018. Subsequent existing building demo and related site work is scheduled to be completed by September 18, 2018.
- Site 207-E-W-7 (Maxey ES) (Replacement) construction NTP was issued on July 17, 2017, with an overall project substantial completion scheduled for May 20, 2018. This project is running approximately 4 weeks behind, with a substantial completion expected within the next week or so.
- Hungerford ES (Replacement) construction NTP was issued on July 27, 2017, with a main building substantial completion scheduled for May 17, 2018. This project is currently a month behind schedule, with a substantial completion expected within the following week. Subsequent existing building demo and related site work is scheduled to be completed by October 30, 2018.
- Pine Hills Transportation Compound a construction NTP was issued on September 21, 2017, for this Design-Build transportation project, with an overall project completion scheduled for November 2018. The project schedule milestones accounted for multiple phases, with the Bus Parking and Staging areas to have been completed by March 8, 2018, the administration building to be substantially complete in August 2018, the driver's lounge and parking, along with the maintenance building to be substantially completed in November 2018. Due to recent



unsuitable soils material discoveries, and additional excavation and replacement thereof, the project is currently experiencing extensive time delays and requests for additional compensation, whereby the Design-Builder is now reporting a projected substantial completion date of June 2019. Based on claims issued by the Design-Builder, additional scope and cost associated with recently discovered unsuitable soils is over \$1M.

- Site 37-M-SW-4 (Bridgewater area relief) construction NTP was issued on February 23, 2018, with an overall project substantial completion scheduled for May 29, 2019.
 - The project recently completed the sand skink mitigation process on May 25, 2018, whereby receiving the necessary HCP permit, providing authorization to commence with construction within the designated 5.3 acre habitat.
 - Due to the delayed start associated with the sand skink mitigation and gopher tortoise relocations, mobilization for construction was not granted until April 24, 2018, resulting in a 2 month delay. The team is currently working with the CM to address measures on completing this project Late June/early July 2019.

Capital Renewal Update as of May 31, 2018

Capital Renewal Update:

There are 45 active projects (21 large, 18 intermediate, 6 small) currently in progress for improvements at 39 sites, with an estimated total cost \$227.7M and construction cost of \$171.4M. These include 11 projects in planning, with an estimated total cost of \$51.7M: 23 projects in design, with an estimated total cost of \$133.6M; and 11 projects in construction, with an estimated total cost of \$42.4M.

These figures reflect an increase in total costs for active projects of \$5.7M from the previous month. This increase is primarily attributable to significant expansion of the scope of the project at Timber Creek High School to add additional heating, ventilating and cooling (HVAC) system improvements (and the associated electrical work) and a fire alarm system replacement.

A significant portion of the program continues in the design phase, with several projects nearing construction commencement. The project at Timber Creek High School will commence in June. Construction is scheduled to commence in July or August on several more projects, including campus-wide projects at Olympia High School, Odyssey and Gotha Middle Schools, and Lawton Chiles Elementary School, and a gymnasium renovation at Ocoee Middle School. The Ocoee gymnasium renovation is scheduled for completion in December of this year, with the remaining projects projected for completion during the spring or summer of 2019.

Design work continues on 17 additional large or intermediate projects; construction on these projects is scheduled to commence in late 2018 or early 2019. Based on current construction cost estimates associated with projects in design, the District anticipates the award of approximately \$100M of capital renewal construction contracts over the next 12 months.

One small project addressing heating, ventilating and cooling (HVAC) systems in three small buildings at Dr. Phillips High School commenced construction in May.

Three small HVAC projects (Jackson and South Creek Middle Schools and Sunset Park Elementary School) and an intercom system replacement at Palmetto Elementary School achieved final completion since the last update. A small project replacing a boiler at Freedom High School and an intermediate project for a new central energy plant for Wolf Lake Elementary School achieved substantial completion.

Planning continues for eleven other projects (four large, five intermediate, two small) that will start construction in 2019, completing in 2020.

- College Park MS (formerly Lee MS) Roof Replacement for Buildings 4, 5 and 6: This campus opened in 1955. The comprehensive renovation in 2010 did not reroof these buildings.
- Metrowest ES Site, Roof, Door Hardware, Cameras: The on-site relief school (Westpointe ES) included adding a new building on the existing (North) campus, which lowered the average weighted age of this campus.
- Dr. Phillips HS HVAC and Controls for Buildings 18, 19, 22: This campus opened in 1986; the buildings impacted here were construction in 1990. The comprehensive renovation completed in 2015 did not address these systems.
