





Building

- 10% more energy efficient than ASHRAE
- High Efficiency Chillers (8% energy reduction)
- Light colored roof reduces heat gain and improves energy efficiency
- Energy Star rated equipment
- Water saving toilets, faucets and fixtures
- All general classrooms have daylighting
- Over 75% of ALL spaces have daylighting
- Fully automated building control system


<u>Site</u>

- Low Impact Design (LID) stormwater design






Third Floor Plan










